

Katavi Wildlife Camp

Katavi Wildlife Camp is located in Katavi national park in western Tanzania.

This pleasant upper-middle range tented safari camp is set on the edge of the main floodplain, with broad views from the main area and all of the rooms.

The camp is owned and operated by the Fox family, who also operated camps in Selous and Ruaha to the south, to which it is connected by a twice weekly light aircraft schedule.

For us the biggest lure to come all the way out west is the chimpanzee experience at in the Mahale Mountains, where the Foxes do not have a camp. For this reason we tend to use this facility relatively rarely, most commonly substituting the rather more up market Chada Camp here in Katavi with Zoe's Camp in Mahale.

But this camp is a decent and slightly lower cost option, which can help to shave costs on what is an unavoidably pricey trip.
