

Katuma Camp

Katuma Camp is located in Katavi national park in western Tanzania.

Set at the southern end of the main floodplains in the reserve, this decent mid-range camp has public areas raised up above a small swimming pool, with 10 substantial guest tents ranged behind.

Although this is clearly a very decent safari camp, we find it a shame that two vehicle tracks separate the tents from the plains and we question whether a pool is really necessary or appropriate in such an arid and wild location.

Katuma Camp is related to and most often combined with Nkungwe Camp in the Mahale Mountains, which offers an awesome chimpanzee experience, adding up to a wonderful seven night safari.

This can be compared directly with the more up market Chada Camp and Zoe's Camp combination in the same two locations.
